## The power of the collective

## Paul Dessau's *The Condemnation of Lucullus* celebrates premiere and Stuttgart debut

On 1 November 2021 at 6 pm, Staatsoper Stuttgart presents Paul Dessau's Condemnation of Lucullus as Stuttgart debut and as the season's first premiere. The production is staged by the theatrical collective Hauen und Stechen. Gerhard Siegel, internationally renowned heldentenor and cast with the title role of Lucullus, returns to the Stuttgart stage where he only recently sang Herodes in Salome. Legendary Primadonna assoluta Cheryl Studer has her guest performance as Tertullia. The numerous other roles are embodied by the Staatsoper's ensemble singers whilst Bernhard Kontarsky takes on the production's musical direction. Kontarsky has been associated with the Staatsoper Stuttgart since 1969, when he conducted B.A. Zimmermann's Die Soldaten und Luigi Nono's Intolleranza 1960 amongst others.

The Condemnation of Lucullus is based on Bertolt Brecht's radio play The interrogation of Lucullus from 1939, in which the Roman general Lucullus after his death is forced to stand trial for his deeds on earth. After WW II, Bertolt Brecht and Paul Dessau developed the play further into an opera libretto. The libretto's sociopolitical utopia and the musical score with its spectacular array of wind and percussion instruments turned the world premiere in East Berlin in 1951, which took place shortly after Germany's separation into two different (political) systems, into a cultural and political scandal. Seventy years later, Julia Lwowski and Franziska Kronfoth (from Hauen und Stechen) together with conductor Bernhard Kontarsky subject the opera to a revaluation.

Hauen und Stechen was founded by the two directors Franziska Kronfoth und Julia Lwowski in 2012. Within the collective, Martin Mallon is responsible for video, Christina Schmitt for the set and Yassu Yabara for the costumes. Actress Gina-Lisa Maiwald, who takes on the role of A Woman's commentary in *The Condemnation of Lucullus*, also forms a part of Hauen und Stechen. All together, they will develop a piece of music theatre which is both, crossing limits and trespassing on genres borders. So far, the team already staged various productions at Opernfestspiele Bayerische Staatsoper, at Volksbühne am Rosa-Luxemburg-Platz, at Berliner HAU and at Théâtre de l'Athénée in Paris.

With the premiere of *The Condemnation of Lucullus*, the Staatsoper Stuttgart returns to a full seat occupancy in the auditorium. Admission continues to follow the 3G-regulation.
